Question 5

Assess the extent to which the European Union and individual European governments are effectively responding to the challenges that accompany freedom of movement in the region.

- How does freedom of movement pose a challenge for European governments?
- What are the root causes of these challenges and what effects do these challenges have on life in Europe?

Question 6

In what ways is Russia an outlier when compared to other European countries? How should European countries respond to Russia's military incursions and growing influence?

- How effective has Russia been at its attempts to wield influence in Europe in the present-day?
- What seem to be Russia's geopolitical goals and what steps is it taking to pursue them?
